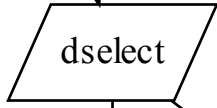
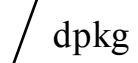


Traditional terminal-based package manager. Originally responsible for tracking available packages and downloading updates; now mostly used as a frontend to apt.



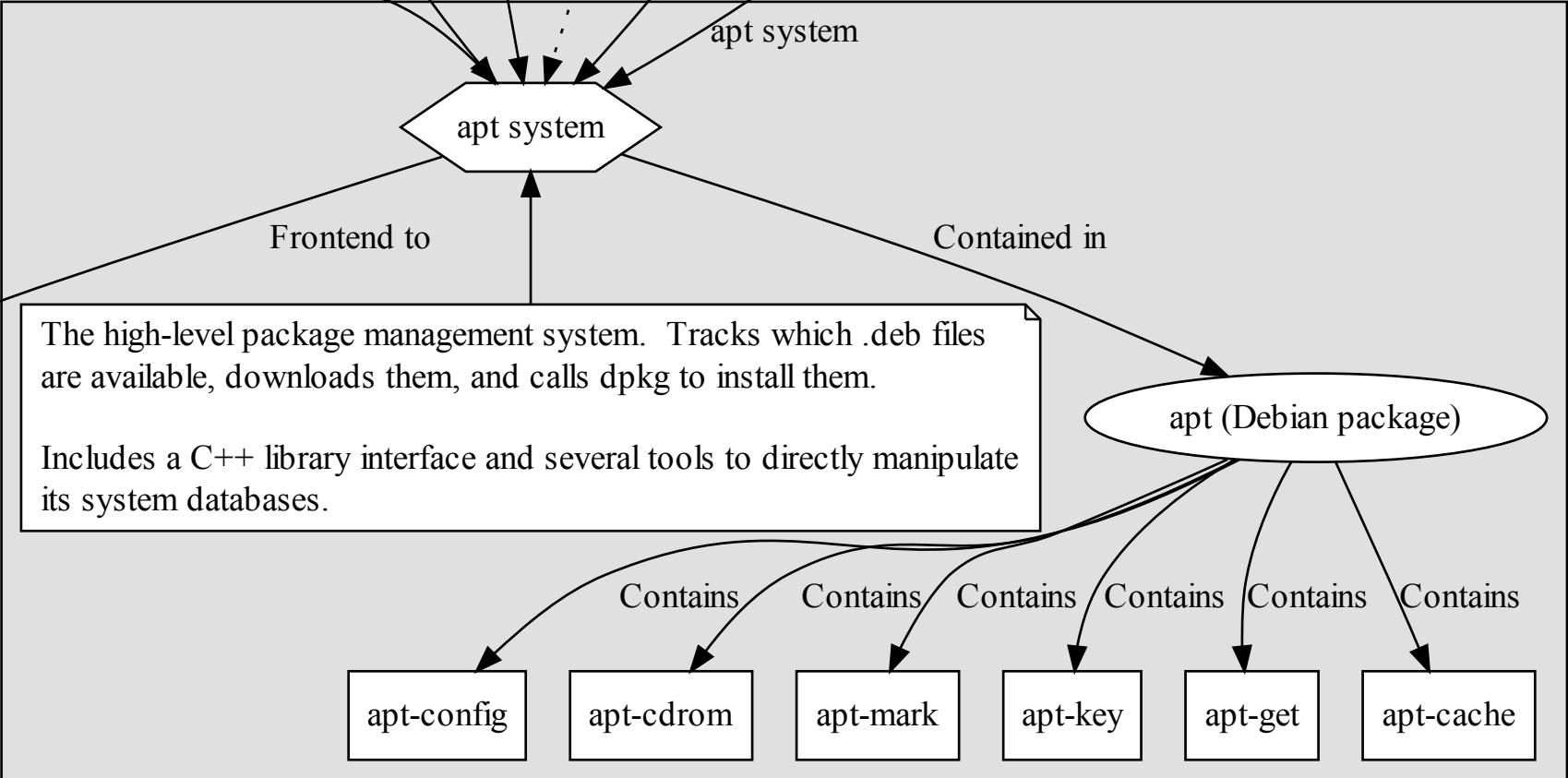
